


Batting Out of Order



Key Items

- Three Terms to know
 - Proper Batter
 - Improper Batter
 - Legalized Improper Batter
- Three Times to know
 - Too Soon
 - Too Late
 - Just Right
- The Proper Batter is always out.
- An appeal might not be advantageous to the defense.
- Three Oddities
 - If the batter who follows the proper batter is on base, he is skipped.
 - An appeal might mean the same batter bats twice in a row.
 - If a baserunner advances during the at bat due to a stolen base, balk, wild pitch or a passed ball that advance is legal.
- Only the offensive or defensive head coaches can make the appeal.
- Batting out of order does not change the official line up/batting order.
